NOTE: This will not be a Shotgun Start. We are experimenting with Staggered Start times consisting of 15-minute intervals. The first 2 groups of 4 archers will be starting at 8:15 am both days of shooting, with the second 2 groups starting at 8:30 am and so forth until all archers are on the course. Following the completion of the FIELD and HUNTER ends all archers will return to the Registration area while the field course is changed to paper animals. Please enjoy a great lunch during this short interval.

Late Registration Saturday only: 7:00 to 7:30 am (see details in the rules section)

Assembly: 8:00 am for reading of Rules and playing of National Anthem

This is a two-day shoot, best-of-two scores. If you choose to shoot both days your registration fee is doubled. You do not have to shoot both days!

NFAA standard 14 Field, 14 Hunter, 14 Animal each day.

NFAA flight system is place for each division with each flight being 5 shooters.

NJSFAA Outdoor Field Championships follows the NFAA November 2021 Constitution and By-Laws.

General Rules for the 2022 NJSFAA Outdoor State Field Championships

- The NJSFAA Outdoor State Field Championships are governed by the November 2021 edition of the NFAA Constitution and By-Laws.
- NFAA or USA Archery membership is required to shoot the NJ Outdoor Field State Championship tournament. NFAA or USA Archery membership cards are to be presented at the registration desk when signing in and getting your score cards.
- **This is a two-day shoot, best out-of-two scores. For all participants that want to shoot Saturday and Sunday, a registration and appropriate fee is only required once to shoot 2X. If you shoot an additional class you have to pay separately for that entry. SHOOT 2X PAY ONCE FOR SAME CLASS! As of April 15, 2022.**
- 14 Field, 14 Hunter, 14 Animal targets each day
- All NFAA Divisions/ Styles & Rules apply.
- We will be using the NFAA flight system for each division with each flight being 5 shooters.
- **Traditional and Longbow archers will shoot from the Youth stakes for Field, Hunter, and Animal Rounds.**
- Crossbows are not allowed in the NJSFAA Outdoor Field State Championships.
- Lighted nocks are not allowed per NFAA rules.
- Maximum Peak Draw weight (compounds) shall be 80 pounds with maximum arrow speed of 300 fps with a variance of 3%.
- Equipment rules are detailed in the November 2021 edition of the NFAA Constitution and By-Laws.

Pro Archers:

1. Since we offer a Pro Division, you can only shoot the Pro Division and not the Amateur Division.
2. Only NFAA Registered Pros at the time of the tournament are eligible to participate in the Pro Division.
3. Registration fees + Pro fees are to be paid. The Pro fee does not include the registration fee. The Pro fee is used for payouts.
4. **If you shoot a different Pro Division/Age Group on Saturday and Sunday, you will need to pay two registration fees and two Pro purse fees, one for each division/age group (Effective April 15, 2022)**

Groupings for State Championships

- **This is NOT a shotgun start. It is a staggered group start – see Staggered Start Times for details.**
- A minimum of 3 shooters per group are required on each target for these championships.
- It is highly suggested that you get your registration done ahead of time so that WAXOBE receives it by August 5th. Target Groups of 3/4 people will be pre-assigned based on this mail-in registration.
- Late registration will close at 7:30 am sharp on Saturday August 7th. Anyone who arrives after the start time will be put at the end of the line as the last shooters out on range, depending on the minimum number of shooters per group requirement. If there are not 3 shooters available, they cannot participate.

Staggered Start Times.

- Two groups of 3 or 4 shooters will go out simultaneously, one to Field Range (Target #1) and one to Hunter Range (Target #15) starting at 8:15 am.
- There will be a horn blown at 8:30 am to start the tournament.
- Every 15 minutes two new groups will go out to Target 1 on the Field Range and Target 15 on the Hunter range, until all groups are out.
- You will complete the Field-Hunter/Hunter-Field courses without a break.
- After you complete both Field and Hunter courses, you will come back to the club house area and then will be instructed when to start the animal round (on both ranges).

Awards:

- Plaques will be awarded to the Champion flight of each division/age group only. Medals will be awarded for all other places within the flight system.
- Belt buckles can be ordered at a cost of \$50 for Champions of each division/age group only. On the NJSFAA Website under Tournaments/Results go to the "Order a Belt Buckle" for directions.
